

**TOWN OF NEWBOLD SPECIAL TOWN MEETING AND BUDGET HEARING AND
SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING OF
NOVEMBER 18, 2021**

A Town of Newbold Budget Hearing, Special Town Meeting and Special Town Board Meeting were held on November 18, 2021 at 7:00 p.m., in open session at the Newbold Fire Station, 4588 Hwy 47, Rhinelander, WI 54501.

The Budget Hearing was called to order by Town Chairman, Dave Kroll. The following town board members were present: Supervisors; Mike McKenzie, Jim Staskiewicz, Mike Sueflohn and Dan Hess, along with Kim Gauthier, Town Clerk and Jodie Hess, Town Treasurer. Four citizen electors were present along with Town Public Works Director and Fire Chief, Mark Fetzer.

Chairman Kroll led the audience in the pledge of allegiance and reminded the audience who is eligible to vote on town matters at the meeting. The Clerk verified the meeting agendas were properly noticed.

Presentation of town 2022 proposed budget and town financial reports. The 2022 allowable tax levy is \$1,137,802, as allowed by the state levy limitations. This is an increase of \$11,866 over last year. There is no balance of debt service owed by the town. The public hearing closed at 7:23 p.m. with no objection.

Chairman Kroll called the Special Town Meeting to order. *A motion was made by Brad White and Jim Winkler to approve the levy amount presented. No objections, the motion carried on a voice vote.*

The Clerk read the annual meeting minutes of April 20, 2021 into the record. *Motion to approve those minutes as presented, by Jim Winkler and Lisa Kroll. No objection, the motion carried on a voice vote.*

Discussion and possible action to set compensation for town officers for the April 2022 through April 2024 term pursuant to Section 60.10(1) (b). There are currently two town supervisor position terms up for election expiring April 2022. The Clerk provided information on the current Town Supervisor salary and training per diems and mileage reimbursement at the federal rate. *No motion or action taken. Salaries remain as is.*

Discussion and action on any other matters allowed by law under Wis. Stats. Section 60.10(1),(2),(3). No comments, nor action taken.

The Special Town Board meeting was called to adopt the 2021 tax levy to be collected in 2022 and adopt the 2022 budget as presented.

Motion by Supervisors Sueflohn and Staskiewicz to adopt the levy and 2022 budget as presented. That motion carried on a voice vote of all aye.

The meeting adjourned at 7:34 p.m., with no objection.
