Stats. Further, should the use of fireworks of any kind start a wildland fire, the responsible party will be liable for the fire suppression costs and may be issued a citations.

Town of Newbold, Oneida County, WI Fireworks Permit

Pursuant to Town Ordinance 9.04:

USER'S PERMIT. As provided in §167.10(3), Wis. Stats., fireworks user's permits may be issued by the Town Board. The Town Board shall require a certificate of liability insurance or similar proof of coverage in the amount of \$1,000,000, naming the Town as co-insured. All fireworks displays shall be operated under the supervision of a pyrotechnics expert licensed by the State. A copy of the permit and proof of insurance shall be filed with the Town Clerk and copies of the permit shall be given to the Fire Chief and the Town Chairperson at least 2 days before the authorized use.

2. You are required to have a permit prior to the use of fireworks in the Town of Newbold.
3. Special Conditions:
 - a. To protect the public health and safety, a permit may be denied or cancelled during periods of high fire danger.
 - b. A permit shall not be issued to a minor under age 18.
 - c. The Town and its officials and employees shall not be civilly liable for damage to any person or property caused by fireworks for the sole reason the Town issued a permit in accordance with the requirements of § 167.10(3), Wis. Stats.
 - d. The permittee is responsible for compliance with the fireworks law, §167.10, Wis. Stats.
